### Summary of Licensing Requirements in LA to obtain a chiropractic license:

- At least 21 years of age
- Of good moral character
- High school graduate
- BA degree from a college or university accredited by the US Department of Education-accredited agency or foreign equivalent
- Graduate of a chiropractic school or college that is accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education or the foreign equivalency to CCE
- Passed Parts I, II, III, IV and XIII of the National Boards of Chiropractic Examiners or a minimum of 5 years active practice in another state.
- Passed a jurisprudence exam given by the Louisiana Board of Chiropractic Examiners with a score of at least 75%

NOTE: A portion of the “pending” applicants were later issued licenses outside of the time frame requested (08/01/2024 – 12/31/2024).
